Parent's Guide to **Dominionopolis**

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Welcome & Instructions:

Welcome parents to **Dominionopolis** 2019. We are so excited for the privilege to encourage and educate your children this summer. Your child will be enrolled in 1 of 3 summer sessions, grouped by rising grade. Grades 1-3 are on July 9th & 11th, Grades 4-5 are on July 16th & 18th, and Grades 6-8 are on July 23rd & 25th. Camps are always on Tuesday and Thursday from 9am-4pm. We ask that your child attend both days, for the full amount of time, to ensure maximum learning and fun. The camp fee is \$25, which can be paid by cash, check, or card. Along with this Parent's Guide, this packet includes your child's Registration Form, a Liability Waiver, and a Lunch Selection sheet. All paperwork and payment are due July 3rd in our offices or sent to our camp facilitator's email. Feel free to contact us to ask any questions. We look forward to meeting you and your amazing child. Mission and Objectives:

Dominionopolis is a 2-day simulation city focused on financial education and modern life skills, taught from a biblical point-of-view. "And Jesus grew in wisdom and stature, and in favor with God and man" (Luke 2:52). This verse is the inspiration for our summer camp. We believe that God wants us to live life walking in His order and balance. This means learning about the mind, body, soul and emotions, as well as finance and community living.

Teaching children to be well-rounded individuals will not only make them better members of their society but will also ease the transition into young adulthood. We at Dominion Financial Management, Inc. along with Community Partners, have developed a curriculum and started this camp as a tool used for positive impact in this community and the lives of your children. We can't wait to share with them the joy and truth of God's word, while allowing them to learn about and simulate adult life.

Drop off/Pick up Procedure:

Please drop off your kids between 8:45 and 9:00 am. We will begin camp activities promptly at 9:00 am. Enter in the Dominion Financial Management door (between the Habitat Restore and Persona Fades Barber Shop). One of our camp counselors will be at the door directing you where to go. Please come inside to drop off your child and sign them in both days.

Pick up is between 4:00 and 4:15pm. Your child will be in the same room where you dropped them off. Please sign them out and check for any belongings. Please exit out the Dominion Financial Management door.

Please drop off and pick up your child on time, as the number of counselors will be limited before and after these times. Only a parent or guardian or an emergency contact can pick up your child. If you are going to be late or need pickup accommodations made, please call our offices (615) 220-5858 as soon as possible.

Rules:

Dominionopolis is directed under a biblical point-of-view. We ask that all campers and their families be respectful of each other and their beliefs. We have 10 camp rules for our campers and ask that parents familiarize themselves with these and go over them with their children.

1. Treat others the way you'd want to be treated.
2. Listen and obey instructors and camp counselors at-all-times
3. Stay within **Dominionopolis** areas at all times as we share the building with other businesses. Campers should stay in supervised areas.
4. Refrain from inappropriate language, behavior or violent actions. Failure to do so will result in a warning upon first offense, a call to parents upon the second, and removal from the premises by parent without reimbursement upon the third.
5. Don't share outside food or food provided by **Dominionopolis** with any other campers, due to allergy and food restrictions.
6. Only eat during designated eating times with adult supervision to ensure food safety and to avoid food related injuries.
7. Please leave all valuables at home. Dominion Financial Management Inc. is not responsible for lost, damaged, or stolen items.
8. Cell phones or use of any other electronic devices, not provided by **Dominionopolis**, are prohibited during camp activities.
9. Ask for help from the camp facilitator or designated camp counselors immediately if you or another camper is in pain, injured, or feeling ill.
